The safety, security, health and welfare of our colleagues, our airport guests, our partners and stakeholders is at the core of what we do each day.

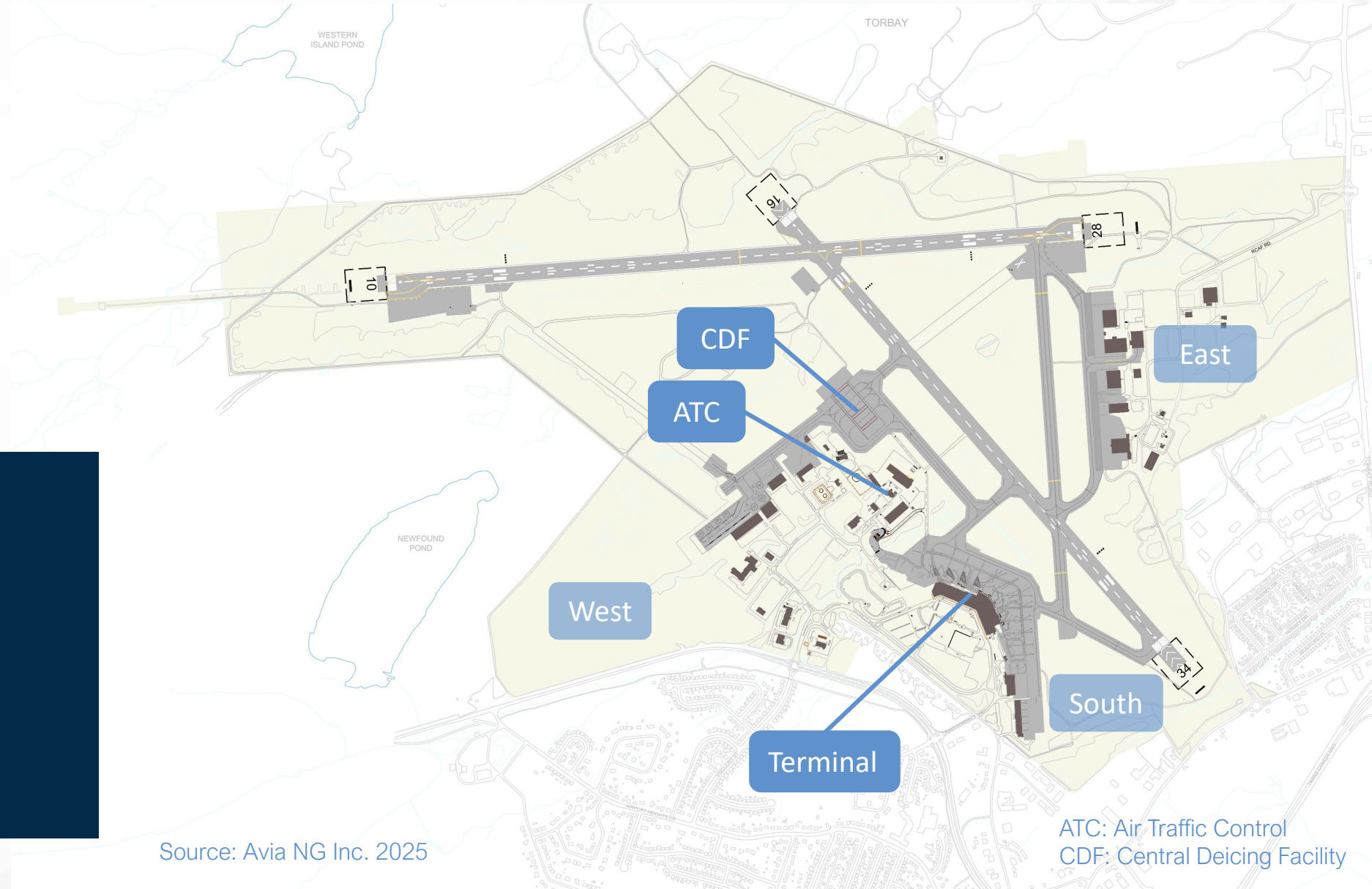
Sustainability

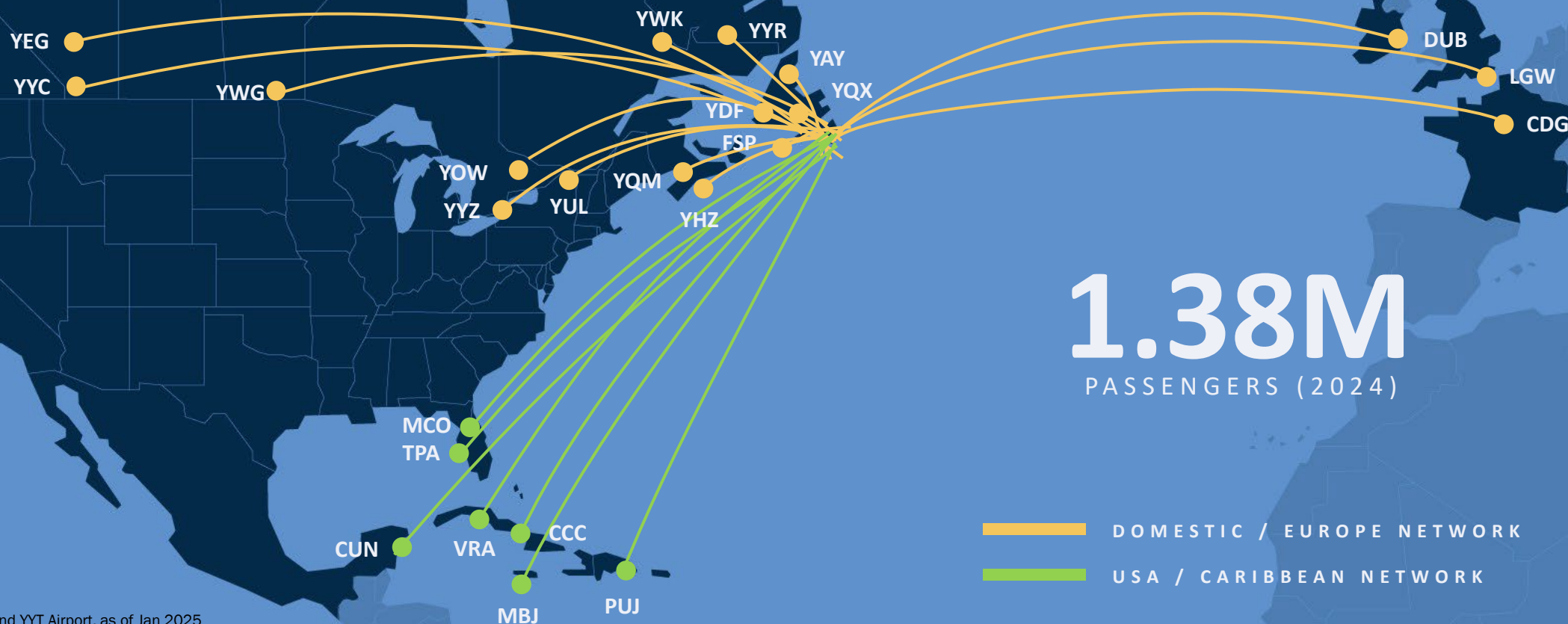

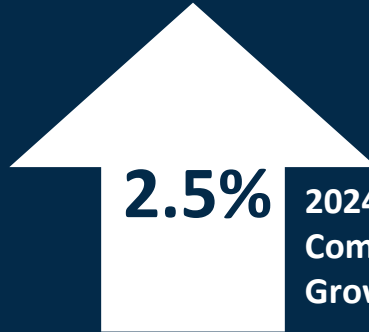
CYYT AIR TRAFFIC FORECAST

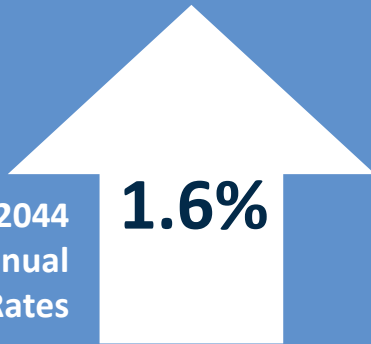

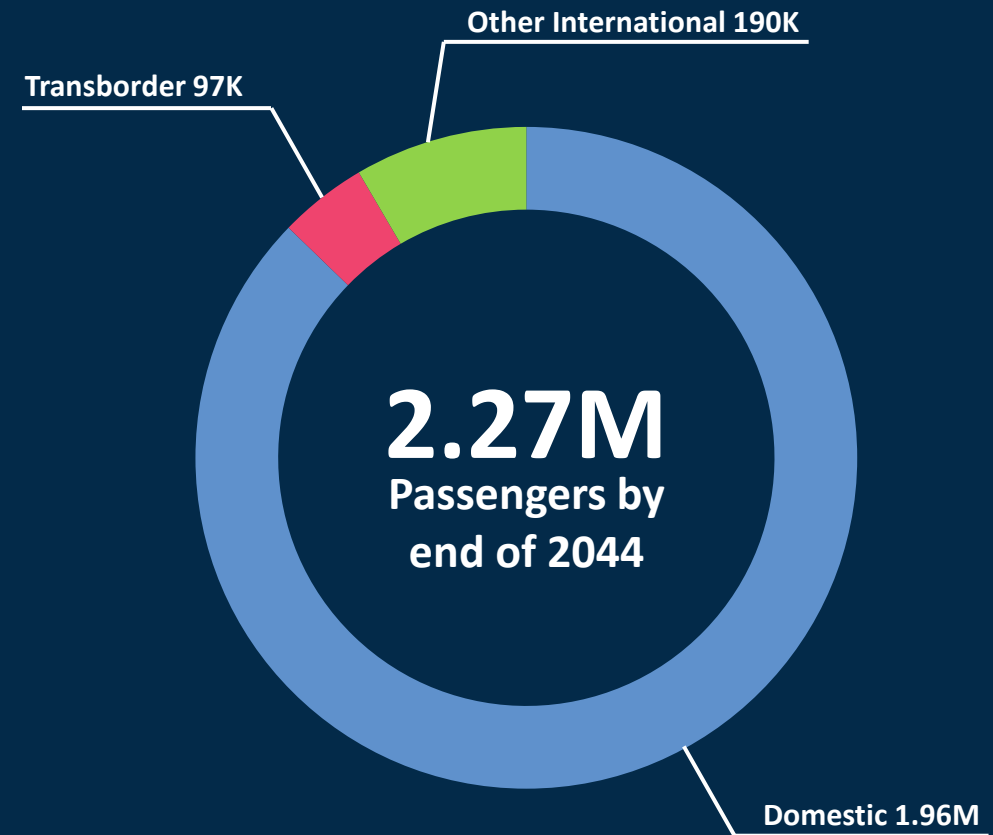
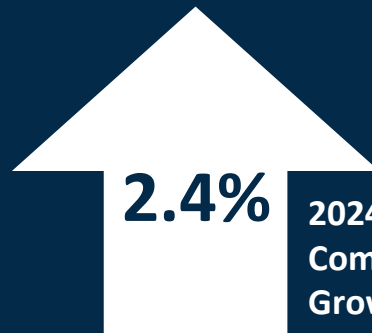
